Summary of the focus group meeting “Connecting Slovenian and Styrian Youth Work”

28 November 2012 in Graz, Karmeliterhof/Karmeliterplatz 2, 2 pm – 5pm

Arrival and Welcome

After the participants have arrived, the team of “Panthersie for Europe” gives a welcome to all participants of the focus group meeting “Connecting Slovenian and Styrian Youth Work” that takes place 28 November 2012, 2 – 5 pm, in Graz, Karmeliterhof.

Introduction of participants

Altogether 28 people participated at the meeting, representing 22 Organisations that are active or interested in the field of youth work within the northern part of Slovenia (Koroska, Stajerska, Prekmurje) and Styria (Austria). From Slovenia were 11 people attending, from Austria 17 people, in addition “Panthersie for Europe” attended with 3 people.

One aim of the meeting is to meet and get to know other people and organisations, that are active in the field of youth work and interested in a stronger connection between the regions of northern Slovenia (Koroska, Stajerska, Prekmurje) and Austrian Styria. Therefore every participant has the chance, to present shortly himself/herself, his/her organisation and give an overview over the fields of action.
